

Jewish Studies Major (30 credit hours)

Examples of frequently offered courses that can satisfy the requirements for the major

30 credit hours total, 12 credit hours must be at the 300 level or higher, 15 credit hours must be in residence at KU; minimum GPA 2.0

- 2 courses in Jewish history and/or culture (6 credit hours)
- 2 courses in Judaism (6 credit hours)
- Intermediate level of Hebrew (usually satisfied by taking 2 courses [6 credit hours] at the 200 level)
- 3 electives (9 credit hours)
- JWSH 601, a capstone course (3 credit hours)
